- Presenting the Australian ruminant genetic industry to international exposure

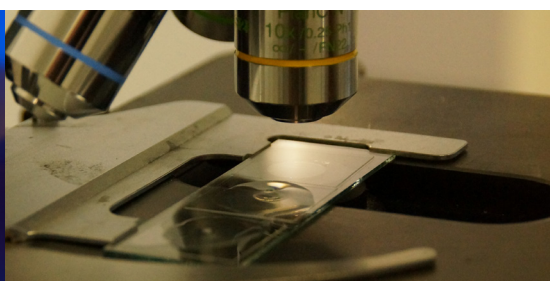
